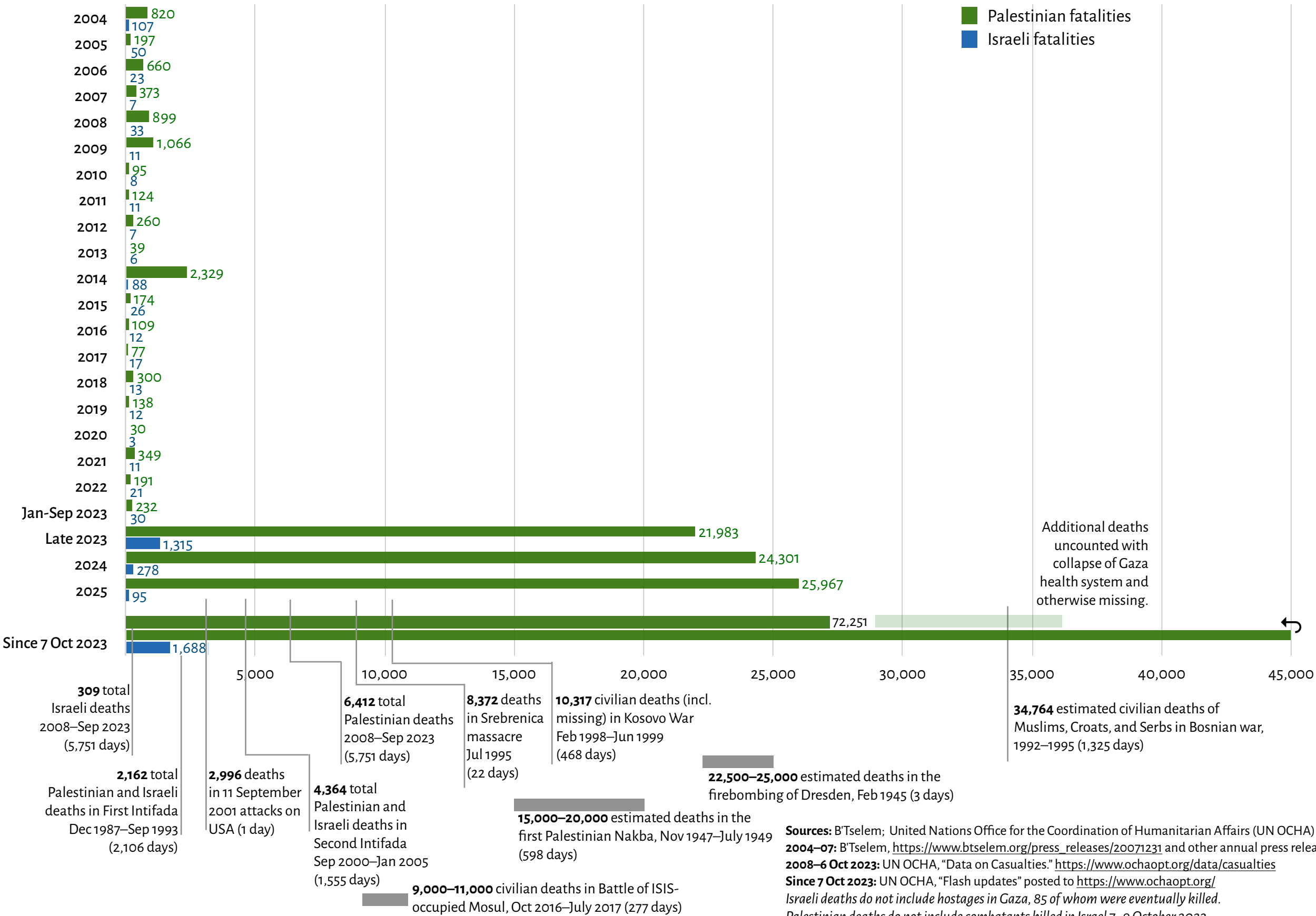


Annual Deaths in the Israeli–Palestinian Conflict, 2004–2025

The current round of conflict, centered on Gaza and surrounding Israeli towns, exceeds the death tolls of both the First Nakba and the Palestinian portion of the Lebanon war, as well as numerous comparable recent conflicts..
